- Schedule regular touchpoints
 - Keep the time on the calendar initially
- Start a running shared document
 - Set aside dedicated time to respond

- Schedule weekly refinement meetings
- Compile a list of stories to review by a certain time

4. Take Good Notes

4. Take Good Notes - How You Can Support

- Think about note-taking system up front
- Consider what makes notes good
 - Searchable
 - Easy to reorganize
 - Easy to copy into other tools
- Ask about favorite note-taking tools
