

The discussion centers on preparing APIs for AI consumption using Postman's evolving platform, emphasizing machine-readable specs, error handling, and governance. Two targeted video series for engineering leaders and developers will promote the AI readiness playbook, expected by week's end. Sterling Chin takes interim head of Developer Relations, aiming to streamline team operations, increase content output, and embed DevRel within product groups. Automation of workflows, enhanced communication, and team culture initiatives, including offsite events and advanced video production, are key components. Action items include finalizing the AI readiness resources, progressing video production, integrating DevRel team deeper into product development, and automating content distribution.

Al-Ready API Content Strategy and User Journey 0001

- · Speaker 2 is drafting scripts for short-form videos aimed at engineering leaders, focused on why to use Postman as it transforms into an Al platform and how to get APIs Al ready. The journey involves moving from API specs through Spectral rules, governance, Spec Hub, collections, private and public workspaces, testing, CI/CD, and publishing on Postman so APIs become consumable by flows and MCP.
- Sterling Chin affirms the direction and suggests emphasizing that engineering teams already have their APIs on Postman, which becomes the starting point for AI readiness. He notes the importance of highlighting internal vs. external APIs and the distinction between private workspaces and public API networks for external consumption.

Definition and Requirements of AI-Ready APIs 3:26

- · Sterling Chin defines AI readiness as APIs having well-prescribed, machine-readable specs and documentation, including clearly defined error states that AI systems can understand. He references his prior talks covering types of APIs (GraphQL, REST) and the gualities that make APIs suitable for AI consumption.
- · The conversation touches on four essential gualities for AI-ready APIs, including machine-readable documentation and error messaging.
- · They discuss a parallel AI readiness playbook being developed by Steven Carr and Talia, intended as a




